COURSE OVERVIEW:	Year 9 Dance is a one year course which offers experiences in performance, choreography and appreciation of Dance. Through both practical and theoretical tasks students will explore the Elements of Dance and study the genres of Popular, Contemporary and Cultural Dance. Dance heightens awareness of, and develops respect for, the body and increases the quality of a student's physical wellbeing and self-confidence. Safe dance skills including mental and physical health will be touched on during the course. Creative and problem-solving abilities will be fostered both individually and in group situations and students will also gain an appreciation and awareness of global issues and develop skills to creatively express ideas.	
COURSE	The course will focus on performance, choreography and appreciation.
