Inventors Lair Workshops


Workshops on various dates for Middle and Upper Primary students. Students attend with their classroom teacher.

Classes attending our Inventors Lair will:

- create inventions with our Makey Makey Invention Kits and the Scratch programming platform.
- Learn about conductive and non-conductive materials.
- Develop skills in engineering, design and computational thinking.

Augmented Reality Adventures

Every day during first break in June with Mrs D in the Meridan State College Library

Every day throughout June in the library in our Resource Centre, students will be able to explore the wonders of Augmented Reality. Augmented Reality (AR) is an interactive experience that combines the real world and computer-generated 3D content.

During lunch breaks, students will be able to colour their own 2D trigger images and will then use our iPad kits to watch their images come to life as 3D models. At random times throughout the festival, classes and students will be able to see our library shelves come to life with the magic of AR. From much loved storybook characters like the Very Hungry Caterpillar to the most feared dinosaurs, they'll all be making an appearance to help our students play, wonder and learn.
