



STUDENT PITCH ROUND 1 - 2024 GREENOVATION ROUND

Have you got an idea to help us make our outdoor spaces and natural environment at Meridan come to life? Maybe you've got an idea for a project or activity that makes our college, classrooms or community more sustainable. Then think about making a pitch to Meridan State College's Marlin Tank - our very own Shark Tank inspired Ideas + Innovation Incubator.

In Term 1, our Marlins are accepting pitches from students from across P-12 who have big or small ideas for making our natural environment better.

How to get involved

1. Brainstorm your idea by yourself, a friend, with a small group or even your class. You can ask a teacher to help if you need some help to get your idea together. Classes can put a pitch in together providing a majority of students support the idea.
2. Put your pitch in 200 words or less. Your pitch should describe your idea and why you think it will improve our outdoor spaces, natural environment or sustainability in our College. List any things that would need to be purchased for your idea. You can pitch your ideas in words, pictures or any media. You can be as creative as you like to help the Marlins understand your idea.
3. Submit your pitch by 5pm on **Friday 8 March** via email to marlintank@meridansc.eq.edu.au

Our team of Marlins will look at every idea, shortlist some of the amazing ideas submitted and then support students to bring some of the ideas pitched to life.
