

## College Priorities 2023

Know the Pedagogy: Enacting the intended curriculum through agreed pedagogical principles to support each student's learning.

Wellbeing: Improving the wellbeing of ourselves and our teams, through the explicit development of personal wellbeing strategies and skills.

### English: Inquiry Question: What makes a book for younger readers an award winning book?

In this unit, students will explore award winning picture books for younger readers to determine the features of these books that make them award winning. Through close reading and discussion, students will analyse the structural and language features used to engage the reader and create engaging characters, settings and events. They will analyse a picture book by Narelle Oliver to present at a panel discussion. They will experiment with the use of precise vocabulary and figurative language. They will use all their knowledge and skills learnt from studying texts to planning and writing their own picture book for a younger reader.

#### Maths:

### Science: Inquiry Question: How do scientists work?

During this unit, students will explore the broad role of a scientists and how they work within different fields. Through hands on activities, students learn how work scientifically to conduct fair tests to understand the world around them. Through investigations into forces, students will learn to work scientifically to plan, carry out and report on scientific investigations. They will identify variables to change, keep the same and measure and explain how scientific tests are fair. Students will explore the way scientific understanding is built through the contributions of many. At the end of the unit, students will plan, conduct and report on the findings of a fair test that investigate the forces at work with paper planes.

### TERM 1 CURRICULUM

### Hass: Inquiry Question: What moments in Australian history were defining moments?

In this unit, students will take on the role of historian to identify and research defining moments in Australian History and what makes them significant. They will use a range of sources to locate details about these moments in history including the events leading up to them, how they brought about change, the people involved and different viewpoints about the event. Students will draw conclusions about what makes this event significant.

As collaborators, they will work together in research group to discuss and share their findings. They will then bring history to life in a short film that presents this historical event in an informative and engaging way.

### Health: Inquiry Question: What makes us who we are?

In this unit, students will explore what aspects make up our identity and apply this to their own life. They will investigate what influences our identity and the changes and transitions which help us to develop and grow. They will describe strategies and support systems that will help to manage change.




