Dear Parent / Carer and Year 12 Students,

The 2023 Year 12 College Formal is fast approaching and students are invited to participate in this extracurricular activity. This year all Year 12 students were invited to join the formal committee. This committee has been meeting and has made significant progress on the planning of this event.

The Formal will be held at Meridan State College in the Sports Performance Centre. Unfortunately, parents are unable to attend however we strongly encourage all parents, guardians, friends and family to join us for the arrivals from 4.15pm to 6.00pm on Tuesday 12 September 2023 to celebrate our students in all their fabulousness.

FORMAL DETAILS:

- The formal will be held at Meridan State College, Sports Performance Centre Tuesday 12 September 2023.
- The cost for the formal will be:
 - O \$110.00 Formal Ticket
- 4:15pm Gates will open
- O Students will be let out of the car by a Deputy Principal. The driver (if not an MSC Student) must remain in the car and leave once the students have exited the vehicle. Arrival photos will be taken by MSC Staff.
 - O Parents / Carers are encouraged to take their own photos prior to arrival off the school grounds.
- Formal commences at 6:00pm
- Formal concludes at 9:00pm
- Only current MSC Year 12 students may attend.
- This is an alcohol-free event and all College behaviour expectations must be adhered to (Student Code of Conduct). There will be police presence on the evening throughout the event.

CRITERIA:

Once the above criteria has been met, students can obtain an invitation to purchase a ticket from **Mrs Jess Bennett, SL Staffroom**. Students can obtain this invitation during lunch breaks from Monday 31 July 2023, Week 4, Term 3.



PAYMENT DETAILS:

Once Students have obtained an invitation to purchase a ticket, they will need to show this invitation at Client Services Finance Window to purchase their tickets.

- Year 12 students are able to purchase formal tickets between Monday 14 August and Friday 1 September 2023.
- Our Finance Office is open between 8:00am 12:00pm, Monday Friday
- · Please note: The Formal will not be invoiced. Payments can only be made to the Finance window once the students have completed their checklist and have received their invitation from Mrs Bennett.

ALTERNATIVE UNIFORM:

- We understand that as this is a special event, which may necessitate some deviations from uniform policy (eg: fingernail extensions), there may be some need to breach regular uniform requirements during the week of the formal. As such, there will be no penalty for minor uniform variations, for the week of the Formal, however, all other uniform requirements will need to be maintained.
- Please be aware that when involved in activities there is an inherent risk of physical injuries occurring without any negligence on the part of the school and in such circumstances the responsibility for the injury and any associated costs will rest with you and not the school. Parents are advised that the Department of Education and Training (DET) does not have Personal Accident Insurance cover for students. DET has public liability cover for all approved school activities and provides compensation for students injured at school only when the Department is negligent. If this is not the case, then all costs associated with the injury are the responsibility of the parent or carer. It is a personal decision for parents as to the type and level of private insurance they arrange to cover students for any accidental injury that may occur.

- Formal meal commences when all students are seated in the venue, scheduled for 7pm.
- Formal concludes at 9.00pm.



ARRIVALS:

- •If traffic backs up, please line up between Halcyon and the entrance gate.
- •If you have a **partner** in the vehicle that does **not** attend Meridan State College, they need to **stay in the car**.
- •Your car door will be opened by a Deputy Principal. Exit your vehicle with elegance and style. Walk towards the hall where the Principal will welcome you and admit you to the Function in the Sports Centre. **REMEMBER YOUR TICKET!**
- •Students will be able to keep on watching the arrivals via livestreaming inside the hall.
- •We strongly encourage **multiple students per car** to allow us to greet the formal attendees in a timely manner.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF CAR AND STUDENTS:

- •Students will receive an **announcement-card** at time of purchasing their ticket which they are to fill out and bring with them
- •This will include all students in your car on the announcement-card.
- •When your car arrives, hand your announcement-card to the staff member with the microphone. They will announce the names of the students in your vehicle and any car details you would like broadcast to the crowd

COLLEGE MAP - SECONDARY CAMPUS




TABLE BOOKINGS:

- Students are to email Mrs Marshall choga38@eq.edu.au a list of a possible 10 students in which they would like to be seated with on the night. Students must include both First and Surnames. Students are encouraged to start emailing groups as soon as possible.
- Our tables seat 10 however if you don't have a group of 10 this is fine, we will join groups together so you have the best possible time!

DIETRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Dietary requirements must be emailed to Mrs Clara Marshall choqa38@eq.edu.au by Friday 11 August 2023.
- Meals will be an alternative drop; thus students will be able to swap with the others at their tables if their tastes alter to what is delivered by the wait staff.
- There will be a vegan / vegetarian option, as well as gluten and dairy free options.

EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENT BEHAVIOUR:

- The Formal is an official school function and therefore alcohol is strictly prohibited even if students are over the age of 18.
- Any student who presents under the influence of alcohol, even if they are over 18, will be refused admission and parents will required to collect the student immediately.
- Illegal substances will be referred to the police.
- Police will be on hand to help monitor traffic and the arrival and departure of students.

PHOTOS:

- A photographer will take photos in the SPORTS CENTER from 4:00 8:00PM.
- Students can have as many group and individual photos as they like.
- Students will receive a QR Code closer to the function that will allow them to register to view photos after the function.

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LEAVING THE VENUE:

- The Formal concludes at 9:00pm sharp.
- No student will be permitted to leave the Formal before 9:00pm.
- Police will be patrolling the area as they depart to ensure their safety as they leave the function.
- No departures from the College grounds will be allowed prior to 9:00pm. Parents wishing their young adult to leave with people other than themselves should inform the College (in writing), detailing the private arrangements made.
