Stationery:

Please note that all items on the Stationery List are required as they support and enhance your child's learning and engagement. Please refer to our website for details about placing stationery orders.

As most items in Prep will be shared, so do not require naming e.g. glue, Sharpies and pencils will be collected by the class teacher on the first day and distributed throughout the school year.

Please ensure items that will not be shared such as books, are labelled with your child's name. At Meridan we appreciate it if all children's books be covered, this helps your child locate their own books easily.



Prep School Uniforms:

School Locker

Our Prep uniforms are available to be purchased at School Locker, which is located in the Maroochydore Homemaker Centre. Please note that the Prep shirt has a purple banner along the sides. School Locker is able to help you purchase the full and complete school uniform and are open 7 days per week.

Home Reading:

Home reading is vital to the success of our students.

Home Reading is a time for families to read together and enjoy the love of reading.

Children progress from having an adult read the books to them, to sharing the reading with an adult during the first phase of Prep. Some children are able to read some of the books themselves, however this is a personal journey. Home Reading commences in Term 1, your teacher will provide further information about this program throughout 2022. Please note that home readers will generally be 'easier' for your child to read. This is a purposeful decision to ensure that home reading is a celebration of children's success with reading.



Other Considerations:

Please be mindful of the number of vehicles that access our College every day for drop off and collection of students. During peak times, car parking and traffic can be an issue. If you have an alternative method for school drop off and collection, such as cycling, walking or catching a bus, it is encouraged.

Please note that the first week of school is a particularly busy time, your patience and understanding help to keep all of our students safe.

Please remember to name all items of clothing, lunchboxes and personal items in your Stationery List e.g. books and folders this will allow us to return them should they be misplaced.
