
Additional Pathways

- Many external options can complement a school-based timetable.
- For example:
 - TAFE at School programs (TAFE) -
 - School Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships

Some options may access VETIS funding.

School based Apprenticeships/Traineeships

- A combination of secondary school subjects, (normal school), paid work and vocational training.
- Contribute toward a QCE
- Student usually works one school day per week but can work additional hours – say, on weekends or school holidays
- Examples: carpentry, childcare, hospitality, plumbing, electrotechnology, IT, aged care, business administration
