COST:	There is an \$80 subject fee to cover costs of consumables and skate deck	
COURSE OVERVIEW:	Students will engage in a range of art making activities which explore art concepts and creative processes. Through individual units students will gain technical skills which will assist them in their art making process. The skills established from studying art will be transferable to other subjects and real life applications.	
COURSE OUTLINE:	Students will engage in 4 individual units and produce a folio of artworks with one major resolved artwork each term. The units will provide learning experiences in; 1. Landscape Painting; students will be taught the skills to paint a realistic landscape. 2. Street Art; students learn about street artists and paint a skate deck. 3. Me, Myself and I; students compile a folio of artworks centered on student created concepts 4. Functional Ceramics; students design and create a series of function ceramics using a variety of hand building techniques.
