

# VISUAL ART

<b>STATUS:</b>	ELECTIVE SUBJECT	
<b>COST:</b>	There is an \$80 subject fee to cover costs of consumables and skate deck	
<b>COURSE OVERVIEW:</b>	<p>Students will engage in a range of art making activities which explore art concepts and creative processes. Through individual units students will gain technical skills which will assist them in their art making process.</p> <p>The skills established from studying art will be transferable to other subjects and real life applications.</p>	
<b>COURSE OUTLINE:</b>	<p>Students will engage in 4 individual units and produce a folio of artworks with one major resolved artwork each term.</p> <p>The units will provide learning experiences in;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Landscape Painting; students will be taught the skills to paint a realistic landscape.</li> <li>2. Street Art; students learn about street artists and paint a skate deck.</li> <li>3. Me, Myself and I; students compile a folio of artworks centered on student created concepts</li> <li>4. Functional Ceramics; students design and create a series of function ceramics using a variety of hand building techniques.</li> </ol>
