Student Recognition Three Year Proposal 2022-2024

OVERVIEW

At Meridan State College, we encourage students to continuously strive towards excellence and to develop themselves as lifelong creative learners. In order to promote this development in our students, we seek to celebrate excellence and implement a consistent approach to positively re-enforce the behaviours we work to develop in our students that are in line with our College Vision and Values.



Staff are committed to encouraging all students to achieve high standards, continuously improve and have the skills to be independent and resilient lifelong learners. *This proposal aims to provide opportunities for every student to access positive incentives in an effort to encourage students to achieve to their full potential and engage in learning experiences.*

OUTCOMES

The core focus of our student recognition guidelines is to promote engagement and ownership of learning while targeting specific behaviours that embody our College Vision and Values.

The student recognition awards integral to these guidelines are:

- General Positive Behaviour Recognition (E.g. 4-star pass, postcards, JCE tracking)
- Academic Excellence Awards
- Behaviour and Effort Excellence Awards
- 4C rewards
- Attendance rewards

The attached document outlines some examples of guidelines, criteria, levels, roles and responsibilities and time frames for positive incentives from P-12. We propose the request of \$15,000-\$18,000 over a three year period.

DISCLAIMER NOTE

We recognise that the total funding requested may not be feasible, however, would appreciate any contribution the P&C association may be able to commit to in order to be able to support this positive behaviour initiative.

We propose that this incentive could be trialled for a 3-year period, and reviewed by presenting data to help support a justification of continuing the funding into the future.
